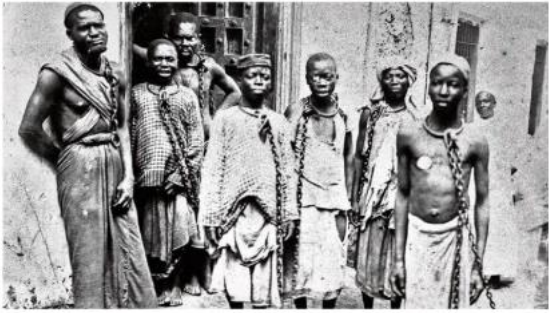

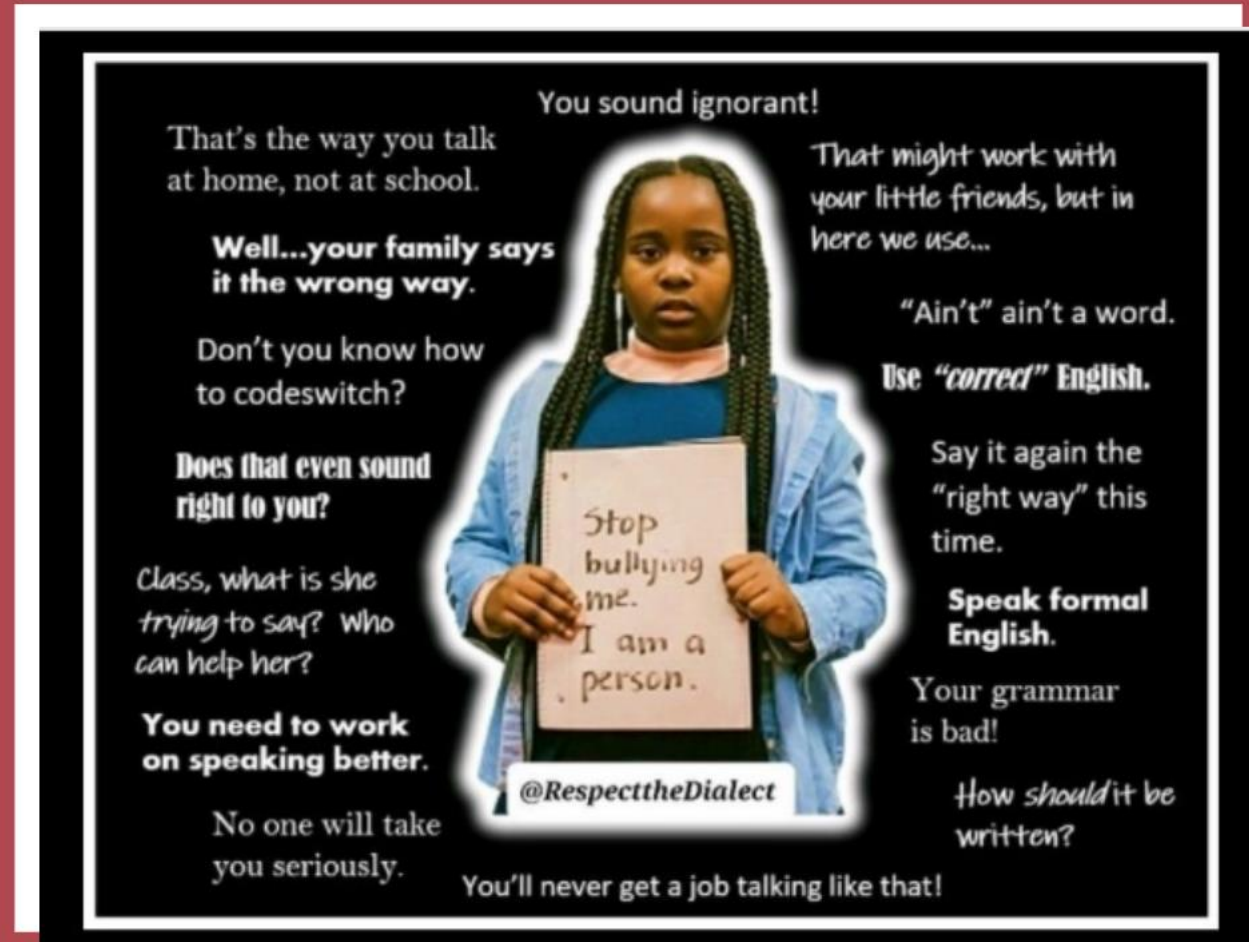
Myfs

Myfs

- Myth of linguistic legitimacy (whose language is valid?)
 - Respectability politics (That was polite fam')
 - Language Policing



Myfs

- **People of Color are not complicit in linguisticism**
- **Specific linguistic practices are rooted in lack of preparation or education**
 - **Linguistic prejudice is embedded in us**
 - **What language do we use to discuss dialectal variations?**

Myfs

- **Respectability is what matters most**
- **Cultural Policing embedded in our institutions - Some of "us" are guilty of upholding the system**

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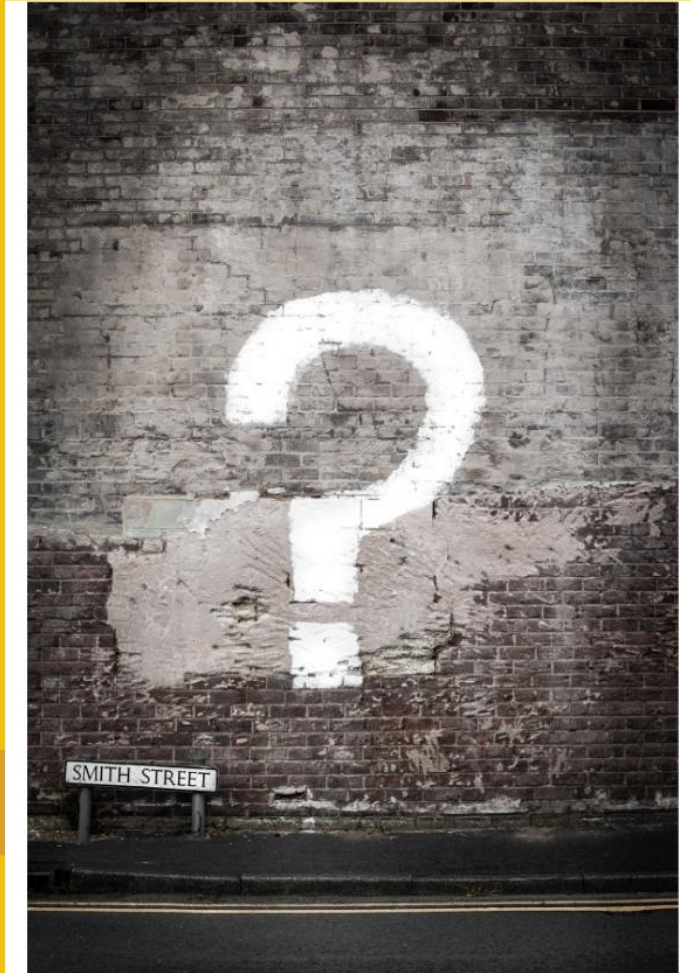
